

ONCE the clusters of masts and rigging of sailing ships dominated the skyline of the Port of Otago. The U.S.S. Calcaterra yesterday showed that only the pattern has changed with the years. Laden with the latest equipment, the Calcaterra, which berthed at the oil wharf, is this season's Operation "Deepfreeze" weather picket ship. The correct pronunciation of the ship's name is Kal-Ka-Teera. She is named for Silver Star winner Herbert Calcaterra, who was killed in World War II.—Report page 8.
